Safeguarding statement and advice

Table Tennis England acknowledges the bravery of those footballers who have recently made safeguarding disclosures and, under the circumstances, feels it is appropriate to offer the following advice to all coaches:

- Acquire your coach licence by visiting the link below. If you have a coach licence and have all your credentials up to date you will appear on our [coach finder](#), which is where we direct all clubs, leagues, schools and partners to. [Click here to purchase your coach licence](#)
- Please make sure if you are working with young people or vulnerable adults that you have an up-to-date DBS check and you have completed this with Table Tennis England or registered it with us through the coaching portal. [Click here to complete your DBS check](#)
- You can also let us know where you coach by completing our new section on the coaching portal, which you can find in your profile and then click on the 'Where I coach' section.

If you do not have an up to date DBS check you must not be coaching young people, whether this is in a club or school environment. We expect all coaches to ensure their DBS is up to date by 1st April 2017.

As part of our duty of care to young people Table Tennis England will be sending out advice to clubs and schools about not deploying unlicensed coaches, which ensures that coaches have an up to date DBS and safeguarding training in place.
